## 2020 Season Addendum To

### Policies and Procedures for State Tournaments

- 1) The following changes are for the 2020 Season only.
- 2) Brackets will be drawn by the Board of Connecticut Babe Ruth League. The schedule and bracket will be posted on the Connecticut Babe Ruth League website one week before the start of the tournament and thereafter no changes will be made.

The Home Team will be designated on the bracket for each game. The Home Team will be designated on the bracket for each game and will occupy the 1<sup>st</sup> base dugout. The Visitors will occupy the 3<sup>rd</sup> base dugout.

The home team for each game will host that game. If the home team cannot host for some reason, then the away team can host the game, but the home team will still be considered as such.

The host team will contact the visiting team by email to confirm the game time and location. The host team will also advise the visiting team as to any special conditions of the field where the game will be played.

Each game will be played on the recommended date on the bracket or the following day.

The host team will afford both teams equal and ample warmup location and time for each game.

The **Home** team must supply the official score keeper and an official pitch count statistician.

Connecticut Cal Ripken Baseball will assign a site director for each game. The Site Director has the final say in all matters concerning the rules or player eligibility.

- 3) Umpires will be assigned by the host team with each team paying 1 umpire.
- 4) There will be a fee of One Hundred, Twenty-Five dollar (\$125) per team for the tournament. The fee must be sent to The State Treasurer prior to the team's first game.
- 5) Each team will supply baseballs for each game equally.
- 6) Coaches are allowed to wear shorts, but all coaches must wear the same color and style of shorts.

- 7) All other rules are in effect as written in the Policies and Procedures for State Tournaments including but not limited to the protest committee, the pitch count rule, the re-entry rule, the 10-run rule and the 15 run rule.
